We focused on several key areas, including health and sanitation, education and livelihood, women and child development, rural development, sports development, and environmental protection. Through our work in these fields, we aim to create sustainable, long-term solutions that improve the lives of those we serve.



In health and sanitation, we have implemented several initiatives aimed at improving access to clean water and sanitation facilities in rural communities. 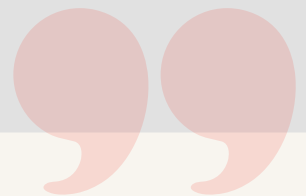

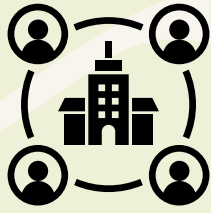

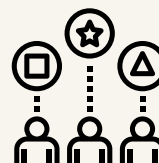
